Greetings FUMC family:

We have received the latest information from the Directors of INDOT 6 of Interstate 69, which directly affects FUMC.

Beginning the first week in January, **Highway 37 will be closed** around the east side of Martinsville. You may travel to Highway 37 by way of **Morgan Street** to 37N. Highway 37N will be reduced to two lanes to State Road 144. Dividers will separate the north and south bound lanes.

Getting to the Church from the South

- The only access to 37N will be at Morgan Street (Prince of Peace Church).
- Turn left onto 37N from Morgan Street.
- You will only be able to make a **RIGHT** turn onto Myra Lane.

Getting to the Church from the North

- You will have to **exit 37S at Morgan Street** (Prince of Peace Church). Turn back around to head to 37N.
- Follow 37N to Myra Lane.
- Turn **Right** on Myra Lane.

Leaving from the Church to go South

- When leaving Myra Lane, you will need to make a **RIGHT** turn onto Highway 37N.
- Go north to Henderson Ford Road (there is a light) and turn right.
- Turn back around towards the light and make a **LEFT** turn on 37S. (An **alternate route** would be to turn **LEFT** onto Henderson Ford Road, go to Centerton Road and turn **LEFT** onto Blue Bluff Road).

Leaving from the Church to go North

- When leaving Myra Lane, you will need to make a **RIGHT** turn onto Highway 37N.
- Proceed on 37N.

Enclosed is a map from INDOT showing the various routes. Later in January 2021, a new entrance to the church will be created near the site of the cross. We will continue to keep you updated throughout the I69 construction process.

Anyone who would like a ride may contact me at 765-318-3412 and I will set up a schedule with the church van. You would find it to be a nice, comfortable ride.

We are fortunate to have our pole barn available. The Truthseekers Sunday school class has been safely meeting on Thursdays at 12:30 p.m. in the pole barn for several months. We welcome anyone who would like to join us for a brown bag lunch and study.
